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VISIT TO GRAVEL PITS: Monday 24 September.

Dear parents /Carers

This term in geography Oak class is studying our local area. As part of this topic we will be visiting *Woodhall Spa Sand and Gravel* to see how our environment is used and how the gravel pits affect their surroundings. We will also be considering how we change our environment to suit our needs. I am sure you will agree that a field trip is a valuable way of understanding our environment. The visit will be on the morning of **Monday 24 September.** I will be transporting the children in the QEGS minibus and we will be leaving at 9am and will return in time for lunch.

The gravel pits are a fairly mucky environment! Please could you send your child to school wearing waterproofs, wellingtons (or at least old shoes that can get dirty) and old clothes. They should bring their normal uniform to change into for the afternoon back at school. A large bag to put dirty shoes in will be helpful also.

We value working with other local schools and businesses. The gravel pits are generously donating their time and QEGS are giving us their bus for a nominal fee. In order for the trip to be viable it is necessary to ask for a voluntary contribution of £2.25 per child to cover the cost of the minibus. The visit can only go ahead if the level of support is sufficient. All children eligible for free school meals (due to benefits received) do not need to make payment as the school will use its Pupil Premium grant to cover the cost for these pupils. There is now also the option to consent and pay online via your ParentMail account.
