Dear Parents/Carers

The children in Maple class will be undertaking their annual day trip to Skegness on **Thursday 22 June**. In the morning they will be visiting Skegness Aquarium. Whilst there they will have a guided tour of the aquarium and observe and learn about the many sea creatures. They will also watch a presentation of divers in the large tank. In the afternoon all of the children will be undertaking a variety of activities on the beach.

The children will not be required to wear full school uniform but need to bring a school sweatshirt/cardigan and shoes suitable for walking, as well as some waterproof clothing, if rain is forecast. A packed lunch and drink will also be required. Please could you provide a non-fizzy drink in a plastic bottle or flask that may be drunk throughout the day (not cartons). Your child will also need an extra pair of shorts and a t-shirt for them to wear whilst paddling in the sea plus a towel and a carrier bag (not swimming trunks or a costume) all named please.

Sun cream and a hat are also essential should warm weather be forecast. Please ensure your child does not bring any money on this trip. Travel pills should also be administered at home if you feel it is necessary. We hope all children will be attending this annual outing which should be a most enjoyable day. If you have any questions please come and ask.

The coach will depart from school at 9.00am and return prior to 3.30pm. In order for the trip to be viable it is necessary to ask for a voluntary contribution of £12 per child to cover the cost of the bus and entry to Skegness Aquarium. Please complete the slip below and return to school by Friday 9 June with your payment. The visit can only go ahead if the level of support is sufficient. All children eligible for free school meals do not need to make payment as the school will use its Pupil Premium grant to cover the costs for these pupils. We look forward to an informative and enjoyable day.
