Topic titles: Heave Ho! The Enormous Turnip.

English Writing to inform – recipes and flyers to advertise bake sale. Seed diaries, commands –

how to plant a sunflower seed. Writing to entertain - comparing stories "The Enormous Turnip" and "Mr Wolf and the Enormous Turnip" and writing own version of this story.

Developing punctuation (commas, exclamation marks, question marks and inverted

commas), expanding sentences, 4 types of sentence and phonics.

Mathematics Counting and number sequences, place value, mental calculation strategies, money and

real life problems, shape space and measures, problem solving using 4 rules.

Science Plants and growing – naming parts of a plant and the life cycle of a plant. Investigating

and growing seeds in different conditions.

Computing Use of digital imagery and coding.

Geography Comparing localities – hot and cold countries and how things grow. Studying maps.

Music Use voices expressively, play tuned and unturned instruments, listen with concentration to

music and experiment with sounds. Sounds of a sunflower.

Art and design Looking at seed art also known as crop art. Children to create own seed pictures.

Food technology - fruity kebabs.

Physical education Athletics and striking and fielding.
