### **English**

Arguments and persuasion. Formal and impersonal writing, instructions, poetry. Animation. Explanation. Deriving spellings

### **Mathematics**

Continuation of work with all four operations (standard methods) and problem solving. Fractions, decimals & percentages. Algebra and number patterns. Statistics (data presentation)

### **Science**

The human body.

### **Computing**

Coding. Creating games and debugging errors. Using the internet to find information. Using ICT as a tool for organisation and presentation of information.

### **Geography**

Kirkby on Bain, including how land use has changed.

### **History**

Skills linked to geography and how places change. In term 2, Saxon invaders.

### **Design and technology**

Food technology.

### **Music**

Singing in parts. Understanding chords.

### **Art and design**

Portraits in the styles of famous artists. Collage and 3D modelling.

### **Physical education**

Invasion games, gymnastics, net games, swimming

### **Religious education**

What does it mean if God is loving and holy? Creation and Science: Conflicting or Complementary?

### **Personal, social, health and economic education**

Self esteem and friendship.  
Circle Time: Airing and dealing with current concerns

### **Homework**

Daily reading; school books, own choice of book, weekly news report (to include locating the story on a map of the world)  
Daily times tables practice.  
“World expert” presentation on diseases. To be completed by the end of term 1.  
Own choice of style and content.  
Weekly guided reading task.
