Advanced notice of upcoming works around the school site

We are very keen to develop the outdoor spaces around our school site and improve our perimeter fencing. We will therefore be updating our site during this term and during the summer holiday. Works will include:

- Removing an area of hedging next to Maple's outdoor area and replacing the fencing to the side and front boundaries
- Re-siting the large PE shed at the school field to create space at the back of school (to the right of the pathway as you approach the pupil entrance from the staff car park)
- Securing this area so that it can be used by pupils during the school day this will create easily accessible outdoor space for Chestnut Two and Oak
- Re-siting the bins along the hedge and outside the new pupil area
- Extending the outdoor area outside Chestnut One
- Slightly extending the Cairn Garden area to allow larger groups of pupils to work in this area during the school day

Our pupils are as enthusiastic as we are about working outside and this will help us to do that more often.
