A vehicle was reversing from the grass island this morning rather than driving around the roundabout and came close to hitting one of our pupils. We understand the frustrations in trying to get your children to school before getting to work but no one wants to get to the point where we are reporting on an actual incident rather than a near miss. Please remember the safety of all of our children has to be the ultimate priority at all times.
